RE: URGENT REQUEST – L.A.P.P.

Civic Service Union 52 is encouraging its members to contact their individual Legislative Member (Call 310-0000 or see Blue Pages of the Telephone Book), to let the Alberta Government know that we are concerned with recent changes to the way decisions are made by the L.A.P.P. Board, potentially impacting our pension plan. While it's important to recognize that **NO CHANGES TO THE PLAN ITSELF HAVE BEEN MADE AT THIS TIME**, changes have been made to quorum requirements and voting procedures. Effectively, the veto power that the unions have had for a 15 year period has been removed.

“Recently (November 15, 2007), changes were made to the way that they L.A.P.P. Board makes decisions about our pension plan. I am concerned that those changes may negatively affect my pension the future. I want you to ensure that the requirement for the labour approval for decisions at the L.A.P.P. Board is restored.”
